Escalante Valley School Agreement

It is important that students achieve, therefore Escalante Valley shall strive to do the following:

- Conduct a comprehensive needs assessment annually using multiple sources of information in determining strengths and needs of the school.
- Establish school goals and individual student achievement standards.
- Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment to enable all students to meet challenging, State academic standards by:
 - Providing a safe climate conducive to student learning.
 - Ensure that education services are provided by highly-qualified teachers and paraprofessionals.
 - Outline a curriculum that has been proven effective through evidence-based practices.
 - Align curriculum, instruction, and assessment to meet the State common core curriculum, performance, and accountability standards.
- Share assessment and evaluation data with parents and/or public by:
 - Holding SEP meetings with parents twice each year to discuss individual student achievement.
 - Providing reports at least quarterly on student progress.
- Ensure communications are sent home in a language that family members can understand.
